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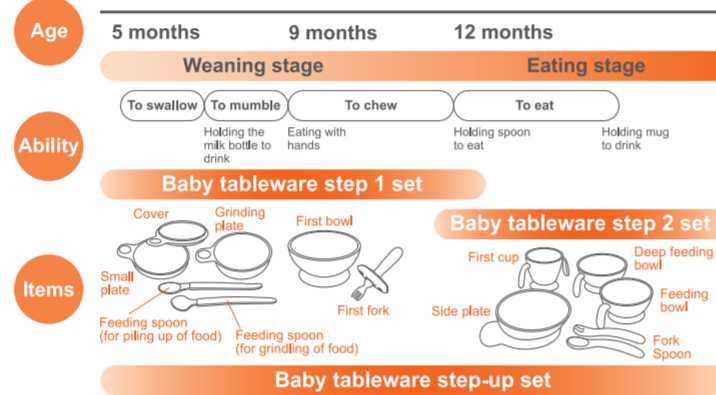
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Before use

- This product is a baby tableware for the purpose of weaning to food.
- Please wash the tableware thoroughly before use.
- There may be bubbles visible inside the product. This is normal and does not indicate quality problems.
- The storage case included with the Feeding Spoon, Spoon and Fork Set is only for storage and carrying purpose. Do not use for other purposes.

Step up illustrations

Baby Label Baby Tableware Step 1, Step 2 and Step Up Set are for step up training in different weaning stages.



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To use it safely

When using

WARNING

- Never leave child unattended while using this product. Always pay close attention to child using these products.
- Parents should always accompany with baby when using this product. Otherwise, baby may hurt its throat and eyes by itself.

CAUTION

- Do not place the product near fire. It may get burnt and melt.
- Do not drop or bang on the product. It may cause damage to the product.
- When using the grinding plate of the Compact Cooking Set, do not use a metal spoon or fork, or other hard or sharp tableware. It may cause damage to the surface area. Always use the plastic feeding spoon provided with the set.
- Please do not allow child to use the First Fork as a teether or soother.
- If any of the items appear to cause an allergic reaction to the baby's skin, cease using and consult a doctor immediately.

When using in microwave oven

CAUTION

- Plastic parts may become deformed, melted, or burnt from improper use when microwaving. Make sure to follow instructions below.
 - Do not use any special operating modes like direct heating, hot plate, oven, grill or toaster mode. Pay particular attention to models that switch the modes automatically.
 - After using the microwave oven in Oven, Grill or Toaster mode, make sure the microwave compartment has cooled down before putting the tableware inside.
 - Do not heat empty tableware.
 - Do not heat tableware which is sealed.
 - Do not heat food with high oil or sugar content, otherwise it may become very hot when heating.
 - When heating food with little water content or little volume, do not apply auto modes and set a short time period and check regularly when heating.
 - Use only within the temperature guidelines indicated on the product.
- Beware of getting burnt. Make sure to follow below instructions.
 - The tableware may become very hot after heating. Pay particular attention when taking the tableware from the microwave oven after heating.
 - Pay attention when opening the cover of the Compact Cooking Set after heating. Steam may come out when cover is opened.
 - Food pigment may stain onto the tableware when heating.
 - Food may overflow upon heating or defrosting. Only fill the tableware to 80% full.
 - Also refer to the instruction sheet of the microwave oven and follow accordingly.

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Storage

- After use, place tableware in warm water and wash with neutral detergent or Combi detergent.
- Do not use if any parts are damaged, faulty or missing.
- The tableware of the Compact Cooking Set can be stacked together for compact storage after washing.



Washing and sterilizing

- Please make sure to wash the tableware properly before initial use and after each use.
- Do not use abrasive washing powder or scrubbing brush which may create damage to the plastic surface. Always use a soft washing sponge or cloth when washing.
- Apply home use neutral detergent when washing. Follow the instructions of the detergent accordingly.
- When sterilizing in boiling water, use a big pot and fill with enough water and boil the tableware for 2 to 3 minutes. (Over boiling may cause damage to product)
- For bleaching, only use kitchen use oxidized bleaching agent. (Over bleaching may cause damage to product)
- Bleach time should be around 30-40 minutes. Follow the instructions of the bleaching agent for the dilution ratio. (Too concentrated bleaching agent may cause damage to product)
- When using other sterilizing agents, please read the instructions carefully before use.
- Open the cover when sterilizing the storage case.
- When applying tableware drying machine, please read the instructions carefully before use.
- Color from food may remain on tableware even after washing or sterilizing.

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Baby Tableware Step 1 Set · Training together

Compact cooking set · About use of Feeding Spoon (for piling food) with case

- **Grinding plate**
There are spikes on the bottom of the plate to allow the grinding of heated food.
- **Lid for microwave oven**
Lid for use in microwave oven to heat or defrost food. Lid can be used with small plate, grinding plate or the first bowl together.
- **Feeding spoon (for grinding)**
The spoon head is flat for easier grinding of food.
- **Feeding Spoon (for piling food) with case**
The spoon head is made with soft material for easier feeding and piling of food.
※ Bitten mark may remain on the spoon if baby forcibly bites on it.



CAUTION

When using the Feeding Spoon (for grinding), please only use on heated soft food. Food which is too hard may cause damage to the spoon.

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Starting set

When baby is about 9 months old or when baby starts to hold and eat by itself, the Starting Set helps to give proper training to baby and encourage baby to eat by itself.

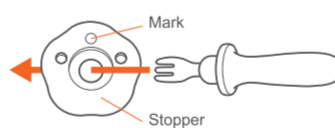
- ※ Start with soft food that can be chewed with the bare gums. (e.g. soft fruit, tomato, fried egg, cheese or carrot)

- **First fork**
Safety Stopper prevents baby from putting the fork too deep into its mouth. Stopper can be removed for washing.

<Installation method>
Hold the stopper with the side having marks facing you. Insert the fork through the opening until it clicks into place.

WARNING

Parents should stay with baby at all times when using the product.



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Training 1

- 1 To start with, parents can feed the baby with the **First Fork**.

Start with soft and small food and then gradually switch to harder and larger pieces of food as the baby becomes more accustomed to eating.



- 2 Parents should hold baby's hand and help it to put the fork into its mouth.

It is recommended to allow baby to also have some fun or play with the fork. Try not to forcibly make the baby hold the fork itself; baby may dislike the fork if training is rushed or intensive.

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Training 2

- 1 When Training 1 is completed, place food into the **First Bowl**, and then assist baby to use the **First Fork** to pick up food from the **First Bowl**.

Gradually change to larger pieces of food as the baby grows.



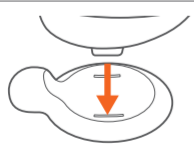
- 2 Parents should encourage baby to use the fork to eat by itself, and make sure baby chews properly.

Make sure baby chews properly when eating to encourage better development of jaw bone.

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Baby Tableware Step 2 Set · Training alone

About Side plate



Snap the bowl onto the bowl stand to secure it as illustrated.

CAUTION

- Make sure to secure the bowl onto the bowl stand before use.
- Do not press on the side of the bowl. It may cause the bowl to flip over.

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The inner side of the bowl is curved such that it is easier to scoop out the food. The bowl stand has a grip to make it easier for the baby to hold the bowl.

About Feeding bowl · Deep feeding bowl · First cup

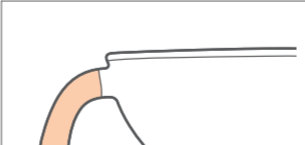


The handles are made with different colors to induce baby to hold and grip naturally.

WARNING

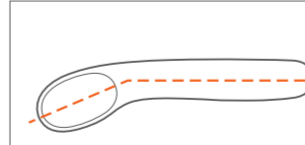
Parents should stay with baby at all times when using the product.

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The bowl handle is thick making it easy for the baby to hold.

About Spoon and fork set with case



The spoon head is curved to help baby put food into its mouth more easily.

Parents should stay with baby at all times when using the product.

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The grip is shaped for baby to hold and scoop food more easily.
